At NERAM you will work with one of the most significant art collections in regional Australia. NERAM is home to the Howard Hinton Collection, the Chandler Coventry Collection, the Armidale City Collection, the NERAM Collection and the FT Wimble & Co. Collection at the Museum of Printing.

As a key member of our team, you'll develop and deliver thought-provoking exhibitions, collaborate with artists and stakeholders, and contribute to NERAM's vision *to be a vibrant cultural meeting place and iconic destination for the New England region, where local and national arts converge to inspire community connection, creativity, and lifelong learning*. APPLICATION FORMAT:

1. Covering letter

Provide a covering letter which introduces yourself, the reasons that you are interested in the position and addresses the Key Selection Criteria.

Refer to the Position Description, which lists the essential selection criteria, and explain how you meet each one. Use the elements in the Position Description as a guide on what to include.

2. Resume/Curriculum Vitae

Provide a clear and concise resume with:

- Your contact details (full name, address, contact telephone number/s, email address)
- A summary of your work experience including where you have worked, positions held, period of employment and brief outline of role/duties performed.

3. Writing Example

Provide an example of your visual arts-based writing (an essay, article, review or response). Any previous piece of writing is applicable.

4. Referees

Include contact details of two work-related referees who will provide comments on your suitability for the position. Referees will only be contacted if you are the preferred candidate.
